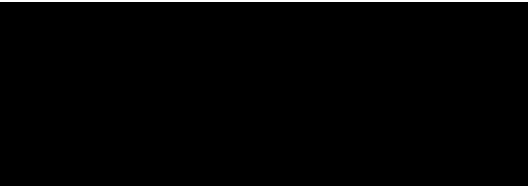

Re Official Information Request – Auckland DHB Car parking income January 2018 to date

I refer to your Official Information Act request of 2 August 2018, transferred to DHBs by the Department of Internal Affairs on 15 August 2018 seeking

Information on car parking income received from all District Health Boards from January 2018 to date.

Auckland DHB does not directly receive revenue from paid public and staff parking.

Revenue from parking is collected by AMP from Wilson Parking. AMP in turn pays an annual fee to Auckland DHB. The fee collected from parking for the period January 2018 to July 2018 was \$2,669,883.

Auckland DHB applies the revenue to maintaining related assets and services such as hospital campus roads linking car parking, providing new car park facilities, and maintaining existing onsite and offsite parking.

These Auckland DHB assets and services provide parking and roading infrastructure for more than 1.9 million patients, whānau, visitors and staff annually.
