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Re Official Information Request - for ADHB staff being assaulted, harassed, injured etc from patients

I refer to your official information request of 20 February 2019 and subsequently extended to 28 March 2019 seeking the following information:

- 1. Data/numbers/figures of all incidents involving any DHB staffer being harassed, assaulted, hurt, injured, threatened, maimed or implicated in an altercation with any patient from any ward/area under the DHB's jurisdiction over the last three years to date (ie from February 20, 2016, to present day, February 20, 2019).
- 2. Could the DHB please, with the data, provide a breakdown of when each incident occurred (ie date), when it was recorded/reported and by who, a brief description of each incident including details of the assault/threat/injury/harassment, and what the outcome was of each incident ie. whether a patient was sectioned/transferred/arrested or whether the staffer involved had treatment.

Our response is provided under your questions below:

1. Data/numbers/figures of all incidents involving any DHB staffer being harassed, assaulted, hurt, injured, threatened, maimed or implicated in an altercation with any patient from any ward/area under the DHB's jurisdiction over the last three years to date (ie from February 20, 2016, to present day, February 20, 2019). Note: Datix Safety Management System was introduced in 2017 and information prior is held on a closed system. Your request for information for the year from February 2016 would require substantial collation or research and is declined under section 18(f).

Could the DHB please, with the data, provide a breakdown of when each incident occurred (ie date), when it was recorded/reported and by who, a brief description of each incident including details of the assault/threat/injury/harassment, and what the outcome was of each incident ie. whether a patient was sectioned/transferred/arrested or whether the staffer involved had treatment.

This part of your request relating to detail data about each incident is refused on the grounds of section 18(f) in that the information cannot be made available without substantial collation or research.

The last part of your request about the outcome of each incident is also refused under section 18(e) as the document(s) containing the information does not exist or cannot be found
